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ALTERNATIVE MEDICINES IN CANADA

- WILDLY ADOPTED (79% OF THE POPULATION USES SOME FORM OF ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE) WITH CLEAR BENEFITS¹.
- TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE IS PART OF ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE AND IS REGULATED BY THE NATURAL HEALTH PRODUCT REGULATIONS (NHPR).
- OVER 6000 TCM REGISTERED PROFESSIONALS IN BC, AB, ON
- NHP MARKET SIZE IS ESTIMATED TO BE ABOUT 2 BILLION DOLLARS CANADIAN ANNUALLY IN 1999²
- CONTRARY TO THE PUBLIC HEALTHCARE SYSTEM, TCM IS A USER-PAY SYSTEM WITH SOME SERVICES **COVERED BY JOB BENEFITS**
- THE GOVERNMENT HAS RECOGNIZED THAT ALTERNATIVE MEDICINES SAVE THEM MONEY^{1,3}
- NHPR CAME INTO FORCE IN 2004

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CANADIAN TCM REGULATORY FRAMEWORK

- REGULATED AS NATURAL AND NON-PRESCRIPTION HEALTH PRODUCTS (NNHPS) IN CANADA SINCE 2005
 - LED THE WESTERN WORLD IN TCM PRODUCT RECOGNITION CLEAR TOXIC HEAT
 - UNLIKE THE UNITED STATES AND MEXICO WHICH CLASSIFY TCM MEDICATIONS AS FOOD SUPPLEMENTS
 - MANUFACTURER AND IMPORTER GMP SITE LICENCE
 - NATURAL HEALTH PRODUCT GMP SPECIAL CONSIDERATION FOR HERBAL MEDICINES.
 - REQUIRE RENEWALS E.G. BEIJING YUBENTANG FOREIGN SITE UNDER PHARMA HERB INC.
 - PRODUCT LICENCES (NPNS) WITH FUNCTION AND INDICATION CLAIMS FUFANG DANSHEN HANPIAN
 - RECOGNIZE CHINESE PHARMACOPOEIA STANDARDS TANSHINONE Π A
 - TCM MONOGRAPHS AVAILABLE TO MAKE LICENCING QUICKER AND EASIER
 - EQUAL TO OTC MEDICATION WITH HEALTH CLAIMS LIKE PANADOL AND TYLENOL
 - PERMANENT LICENSES NO RENEWAL









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CANADIAN TCM REGULATORY FRAMEWORK

CONT'D

- 99% OF THE SINGLE HERBS IN THE 2020 CHINESE PHARMACOPOEIA ARE LICENSED
 - INCLUDING POTENTIALLY TOXIC INGREDIENTS XIXIN, CAOWU, CHUANWU AND FUZI ETC.
 - CLASS I II AND III WITH CLASS I AND II ARE MONOGRAPH BASED
 - THE SAME MEDICINE HAS DIFFERENT FORMULATION IN CANADA, AND PARTS OF CHINA (ANGONG NIUHUANG WAN)
- CANADA HAS STRICT STANDARDS ON PRODUCT IMPURITIES FOR NHP (TCM)
 - TOUGHEST IN HEAVY METAL, ALSO INCLUDES MICROBIAL, SOLVENTS, PESTICIDES AND MYCOTOXINS
 - MUST MEET CHINESE (PHARMACOPOEIA) AND <u>CANADIAN STANDARDS</u>
- REGULATION MOTIVATED MOSTLY BY FINANCIAL INTEREST
 - SAVE THE COST OF THE PUBLICLY FUNDED HEALTH CARE SYSTEM



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PRODUCT AND SITE LICENCING RESPONSIBILITIES

- MEET CHINESE AND CANADIAN SAFETY, QUALITY AND EFFICACY RESPONSIBILITIES
 - PRODUCTS MEET LICENCING REQUIREMENTS GMP TO ENSURE SAFETY, EFFICACY AND QUALITY
 - LABELLING ACCORDING TO LICENSE AND BILINGUAL IN ENGLISH AND FRENCH
- DOCUMENTED OPERATION ACTIVITIES TO DEMONSTRATE COMPLIANCE
 - PRODUCT RELEASE, TESTING, STORAGE, TRACING, RECALL, STABILITY, CHANGE

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KEY STRATEGIC ADVANTAGES, RISKS/OPPORTUNITIES OF TCM

- CANADIAN INFRASTRUCTURE IS READY FOR USERS CURE DISEASES
 - GOOD CLINICAL EXPERIENCE MAKES BELIEVERS IN TCM, MAINSTREAM ADOPTION GROWING
- SELF-CARE FRAMEWORK AND TCM
 - CANNOT REGULATE NATURAL HEALTH PRODUCTS THE SAME AS NON-PRESCRIPTION DRUGS⁴
 - CAN WE TIGHTEN THE OVERSIGHT OF NHPS WHILE THEY ARE CONSIDERED FOOD IN THE US?
 - NO EXTRA COST IN LICENCING IN THE US, CANADIANS CAN BUY PRODUCTS ONLINE
 - NEED CONSTANT GUIDANCE AND FEEDBACK TO NNHPD ON OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES (2024 MIRABILITUM PRAEPARATUM)
- MUCH WORK IS STILL AHEAD, FINE-TUNING THE REGULATING OF THE MEDICINE PART OF TCM



2007MEDLINE, EMBASE, Chinese Biomedical Database (CBM), and the Cochrane Center Controlled Trials Register – The paper searched randomized controlled trials databases of compound danshen preparation for the treatment of unstable angina published in any language, mainly comparing compound danshen preparation and western medicine with western medicine alone. A total of 17 randomized clinical trials were included, involving a total of 1462 patients.

The Characteristics and treatment methods of Liver Yang Ascension
